Mr. Shanoff::

I have for reference your article "Time to shine light on Tarion" February 21, 2005.

On February 11, 2015 I filed an application for leave to appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada concerning what I perceive to be flawed legislation in the statute establishing Tarion. Copies of my Notice of Application for Leave to Appeal and Memorandum of Argument are attached. Tarion's deadline is March 13th, 2015. I have made vigorous attempts to persuade Tarion to have the Ministry of

Government and Consumer Services look at this but I struck out. The question is – Why? Surely the points you make in your article are only reasonable. An institution without checks and balances, without, as you put it, transparency, is potentially a rogue institution.
